

## **Instruction for Zoology TA Application - Fall 2017**

- 1. Electronic applications only. Fill out the form and supplemental documents (first time applicants) via email.
- 2. If you are selected as a TA for the fall semester, you are required to be on campus during the welcome week, August 28-September 1. Your appointment will begin on August 28.
- 3. International students <u>must</u> pass the SPEAK TEST to be considered for a TA position. Further information about the test can be found on the web (http://www.english.wisc.edu/esl/itatraining-speak.htm).
- 4. If you are a first time applicant for a Zoology TA position:
  - Attach a current resume.
  - Attach copies of all of your college transcripts. Highlight all biology, chemistry, math, statistics and physics courses you've taken. Unofficial copies are fine.

**TAs for upper level courses** (those numbered 300 and above) are selected by the faculty of each course. To be considered for any of these courses:

- Include such courses in your preference ranking
- Submit a second copy of your resume and a written statement with your application. Your application will be forwarded to the faculty teaching the course and if the position is filled, you will be notified.

## Fall 2017 Zoology courses for which we expect to hire TAs

- Zoology 101- Introductory Zoology (50%, 3TAs)
- Zoology 102 Introductory Zoology Lab (several TAs)
- Zoology 151/152 Intro biology –lab and discussions (several TAs)
- Zoology 430 Comparative Anatomy of the Vertebrates (1-50% TAs)

Once all applications are reviewed, we will call you for an interview. This can happen while the spring semester is in session or during the summer. If you are not in Madison, we can arrange a phone or Skype interview. Please check your email regularly over the summer.

Please note that we still don't know what our TA budget will be. Although we do not anticipate any cuts to the instructional budget, the percentages and number of TAs assigned to each course may be different between now and the time of appointment.
